Women are invited to share personal successes and challenges, beliefs, fears, and anxious feelings about pregnancy or being a mom when they might be struggling with an eating disorder, disordered eating, or unhealthy thoughts and emotions. All are welcomed to join; participation is not required. Simply listening to and learning from others often helps alleviate guilt and shame, reduces stigma, and eradicates the feeling of being alone.
